Mary Ogilvy Bargaining Schedule

Mary Ogilvy management has proposed to schedule the first bargaining meeting in June 2026, while also committing to provide management's bargaining position in writing ahead of the meeting.

This follows the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) providing our Log of Claims (LoC) to Mary Ogilvy management on Tuesday 21 April 2026.

The *Mary Ogilvy Homes Society Nursing & General Staff Agreement 2023* provided for a wage increase from 1 July 2025, and we say you are due for a bargained wage increase from 1 July 2026.

1 July is also the date on which the Fair Work Commission (FWC) adjusts minimum award wages in Australia each year in the Annual Wage Review, taking cost of living into account.
