Employee Self Service Update

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) are aware that many members have been affected by the inability to access the Employee Self Service (ESS) from an external device. The Department of Health (DoH) have acknowledged these concerns and have provided the following update.

Department of Premier and Cabinet (DPAC) is leading work to restore external ESS access across the Tasmanian State Service (THS), in consultation with impacted agencies including DoH, while ensuring that payroll processing is not disrupted.

Current ESS/payslip access options:

- Workplace (internal) access - ESS remains available on workplace computers on the DoH network.
- External access - ESS can be accessed externally via DoH-issued devices, and via the State Government's Statewide Wi-Fi Access Program - <https://www.tas.gov.au/digital/wi-fi-program>.
- People Connect - if the employee is still not able to access their payslip or if there is an urgent need to do so, they can request one from People Connect by calling 1300 812 535 or by sending a request via the Portal.

DPaC has advised that external ESS availability is scheduled to return on **Tuesday 12 May 2026** (timed to avoid impacting the main DoH pay-run processing).

The Department has committed to regular updates via internal staff communication channels.
