Corumbene Log of Claims Presented

At the Enterprise Agreement (EA) bargaining meeting on Tuesday 12 May 2026 your Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) bargaining team spoke to our Log of Claims (LoC).

Corumbene management indicated it was open to having further discussion about a number of items in our LoC.

Wages Situation

We are looking to verify that Corumbene management has correctly provided you with the wage increases due to you from the:

- Existing EAs; and,
- The Aged Care Work Value Case in the Fair Work Commission (FWC).

Some time ago the ANMF asked Corumbene management for information on the wages it currently pays employees and we are not fully satisfied with the response Corumbene management recently provided.

We would like more information and assistance from members to understand what wage increases you have received since 2023.
