

ANMF EBA UPDATE 9

Nursing and Midwifery Public Sector Enterprise Agreement Bargaining Update

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) has been advised by the lead negotiator for the Nursing and Midwifery Public Sector Enterprise Agreement (EA) negotiations that the Department of Health (DoH) bargaining team have not yet received their bargaining parameters.

Essentially, this means that the lead negotiator has not been provided with instructions from the Public Sector Industrial Relations Committee (PSIRC) on their scope to bargain on our claim items. As a result, yesterdays and next **Tuesday 16 June 2026** negotiation meetings have been postponed while the lead negotiator receives the bargaining parameters at the next scheduled PSIRC meeting which will then enable a preliminary response to the ANMF's Log of Claims (LoC) on **Tuesday 23 June 2026**.

The ANMF continue to use this time to provide further evidence and information to the lead negotiator and the bargaining team to support the ANMF's LoC, highlighting the importance of each claim item to nurses and midwives working across the Public Sector.

The ANMF remain committed and ready to bargain in good faith to progress the interest of nurses and midwives industrial and professional claim items to improve members entitlements and working conditions.
