Clinical Nurse Consultants, Clinical Midwife Consultants and Project Nurse Members Call for Expressions of Interest – Workplace Organising Committee

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) is calling for Expressions of Interest from Clinical Nurse Consultants (CNCs), Clinical Midwife Consultants (CMCs) and Project Nurses to join a Workplace Organising Committee (WOC). Expressions of Interest (EOIs) are due by **close of business Friday 31 July 2026**.

The ANMF has received reports that a review is currently being undertaken of CNC, CMC and Project Nurse positions across Hospitals South.

These Grade 6 nursing and midwifery roles are critical to the delivery of safe, high-quality, evidence-based care. They provide expert clinical leadership, support service improvement, drive best practice and contribute significantly to patient outcomes and system performance within an increasingly complex healthcare environment.

At this stage, the ANMF has not been advised of the intent or potential outcomes of the review. However, members have expressed concerns about what any future recommendations may mean for these important roles. While it remains unclear whether the review will result in a formal change proposal, the ANMF is proactively preparing to ensure members have a strong voice in any future consultation process.

To support this work, the ANMF is seeking EOIs from CNCs, CMCs and Project Nurses who would like to participate in a WOC.

The purpose of the WOC will be to:

- Monitor developments arising from the review.
- Identify and raise member concerns.
- Assist the ANMF in understanding the impact of any proposed changes.
- Support advocacy aimed at protecting and strengthening these important positions.
- Ensure the views and experiences of affected members are accurately represented throughout any consultation process.

Please note that Nurse Practitioner Candidates and Clinical Nurse/Midwife Educators have reportedly been excluded from the current review and are therefore not the focus of this WOC.

Expressions of Interest are requested by close of business Friday 31 July 2026.
