Member Meeting Update Wednesday 8 July 2026

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) appreciates members taking the time to meet with the new ANMF organiser and share the current issues impacting the workplace.

The ANMF stands with members at Millbrook Rise Centre and is committed to strong, member-led advocacy to ensure your workplace concerns are heard, taken seriously, and progressed. Members have clearly identified serious issues including staff shortages, safe staffing, appropriate skill mix, and broader work health and safety concerns that require action.

Members also raised significant safety concerns about transporting clients to and from appointments and supporting movement within the facility, particularly where there is no security presence or camera coverage. The ANMF will continue to advocate for these concerns to be addressed as a priority, recognising that safe systems of work are essential to protect both members and clients.

To strengthen this advocacy and ensure all member voices are heard, the ANMF is seeking to arrange a further member meeting in the coming weeks, including opportunities for members across different shifts to participate. Strong member engagement is vital to building collective action and achieving safer staffing, safer systems, and a safer workplace.

This follow-up meeting will provide a further opportunity for members to discuss these issues and identify practical steps to promote a safe workplace for staff and clients.

Members are encouraged to continue engaging with the ANMF and to raise any additional concerns with the organiser so they can be captured and progressed appropriately.
