

ANMF EA UPDATE 7

Melaleuca Home for the Aged

Voting Closed – Ballot Results – YES

Voting for the proposed **Melaleuca Home for the Aged Registered Nurses and Enrolled Nurses Enterprise Agreement 2026** closed today.

A total of 30 eligible Melaleuca employees participated in the ballot. To be eligible to vote, employees must have been employed from the start of the access period through to immediately after voting commenced.

The outcome of the vote is **YES**:

Eligible voters	30
Responses	15 (50% response rate)
No Votes	0 (0%)
Yes Votes	15 (100% Majority)

What Happens Next?

Within 14 days of the ballot closing, your Employer must lodge the proposed **Melaleuca Home for the Aged Registered Nurses and Enrolled Nurses Enterprise Agreement 2026** (and associated paperwork) with the Fair Work Commission (FWC) for consideration and approval.

Once approved by the FWC, the new Agreement will commence seven (7) days after the date of approval.



From that point, all agreed wage increases and other improvements secured through bargaining will become enforceable.
