The ANMF Seeks Member Feedback on Proposed SMHS Relocation

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) has been advised of a Department of Health Change Proposal affecting Statewide Mental Health Services (SMHS) members currently located on Level 13, 110 Collins Street.

The proposal would see remaining SMHS teams and staff relocated to 175 Collins Street before **Monday 17 August 2026**, subject to consultation outcomes and final accommodation arrangements.

What is Proposed?

The Department is proposing Stage 1 relocations to the Ground Floor, Tenancy 5 Level 2, and Tenancy 3 Level 2 at 175 Collins Street. The proposal affects several SMHS teams, including Mental Health Strategy and Reform, Recovery College, and a small number of Acute Care Stream staff.

What ANMF Members Should Consider

Whether the proposed move will affect access, commute times, parking, safety, or daily work arrangements.

Whether members have enough information about desk allocation, site access, timing, equipment, and relocation support.

Whether there are any workload, service delivery, or work health and safety impacts that need to be raised.

Whether members have alternative suggestions or practical issues the ANMF should put to the Department.



The ANMF will represent members through the consultation process and attend consultation meetings hosted by the Department of Health. The ANMF will use member feedback to raise concerns, seek clarification, and advocate for practical issues to be addressed before any relocation occurs.
