Statewide Mental Health Services Relocation Change Proposal Feedback

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) has consulted with members of Statewide Mental Health Services (SMHS) regarding the change proposal for the relocation of some teams and staff from 110 Collins Street to 175 Collins Street.

The ANMF can advise that no feedback was received from members in relation to this change proposal.

The ANMF has, however, received member feedback relating to a second change proposal. This second proposal has not yet been created or formally provided to the ANMF. Once the second proposal is received, the ANMF will again consult extensively with members to ensure your feedback, workplace knowledge and concerns are central to the consultation process.

The ANMF will continue to stand with members, advocate for genuine consultation, and protect safe workloads, fair working conditions and quality care across SMHS.

Member Action: Please keep an eye out for further ANMF updates and participate in consultation when the second change proposal is released. Your feedback helps the ANMF advocate collectively for safe staffing, sustainable workloads and fair outcomes for members.
