ANMF members are seeking a dedicated nurses and care workers agreement:

- An agreement focused on the people who deliver care.
- An agreement that recognises the skills, responsibilities and contribution of care workers.
- An agreement drawing on the best conditions across all existing agreements.
- An agreement that strengthens protections, improves conditions and gives nurses and care workers a stronger collective voice.

We expect to meet with OneCare management in coming weeks to start bargaining.
