ANMF Snap Poll – Classification Information

As previously reported, Corumbene management's revised bargaining offer involves changes to classifications and pay points.

Here are some examples:

- Corumbene management is proposing changes to the nurse classification structure that would reduce the number of pay points at each Level.
- Corumbene management is proposing that nurses who have attained Registered Nurse (RN) Level 1 Year 8 will automatically advance to RN Level 2.
- Corumbene management is also flagging changes to the classification structure for care workers but is yet to work through the details. We intend to engage with members to influence the approach taken.

So that your Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) bargaining team can advocate for the best possible outcomes at the bargaining table, we need some information from members.
