Launceston General Hospital Change Proposal Relocation of Health Information Services

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) has recently received notice of the proposal to relocate the Health Information Services/Health Service Operations teams.

The Change Proposal dated Tuesday 25 August 2026, and received on Wednesday 2 September 2026, indicates the above services are to be relocated to 186 Brisbane Street, Launceston, to allow the currently used Level 2 space to be reallocated to clinical services as part of the Launceston General Hospital (LGH) Masterplan.

A date for the relocation has not been provided as renovations to 186 Brisbane Street will need to be finalised first. Once the services have relocated a small record return room will be maintained at the LGH, but the bulk of the services will operate from Brisbane Street.

It has been identified that the impact on patient services will be minimal, with most communications with patients conducted via phone, email or MS Teams.
