The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation (ANMF) has been collaborating with the Commonwealth Public Services Union (CPSU) over all wages, conditions and employment matters that affect Commonwealth employees. We are approaching meeting 11, however most claims discussed so far have been CPSU's.

The ANMF has been contacted by various individual Departments and Agencies to commence bargaining at Agency level. We will update you shortly in relation to that.

Survey responses have been collected and an ANMF Log of Claims (LoC), mainly supporting the CPSU claims, was developed, focusing on broadening the Commonwealth Nurse Allowance.
