Only statements which comply with the Federation's Rules and are received by the Returning Officer by 12 noon AEDT Tuesday 15 October 2019 can be accepted.

Voting Period

The ballot, if required, will open on Friday 8 November 2019 and close at 5pm AEDT on Monday 2 December 2019.

Scrutineers

Note: Rule 87.1 A candidate in any Branch election may, if he or she so desires, appoint a scrutineer who is a financial member of the Federation to represent him or her at the ballot. The person appointing a scrutineer shall before the commencement of the ballot, notify the Returning officer in writing of the name of such scrutineer.

The appointment of scrutineers closes 9:30am AEDT on Tuesday 3 December 2019.
