Lodging Nominations

Nominations open on 17 September 2019 and must reach the Returning Officer, Ann Dougan not later than 12 noon Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) on Tuesday 8 October 2019.

Nominations cannot be withdrawn after 12 noon AEDT on Tuesday 8 October 2019.

Prospective candidates and nominators should verify their financial status and any other qualifications required by the Federation's rules prior to lodging nominations.

Note: Rule 84.1 A candidate for election to the office of Branch Councillor shall have been a financial member of the Federation for a period of one year immediately preceding the date of nomination for office and shall be a member of the branch in which they are nominating for office at the date of nomination for office.

Note: Rule 84.4 Candidates must be nominated by three other financial members of the Branch.

Scrutineer Appointment

Note: Rule 87.1 A candidate in any Branch election may, if he or she so desires, appoint a scrutineer who is a financial member of the Federation to represent him or her at the ballot. The person appointing a scrutineer shall before the commencement of the ballot, notify the Returning Officer in writing of the name of such scrutineer.

The appointment of scrutineers closes 9:30am AEDT on Tuesday 3 December 2019.
