Notification to members:

Rule 49.2.1 Within a period of twenty-one days before the date of commencement of the period for lodging nominations of candidates for an election for office, cause to be published in a newspaper or newspapers a notice setting out:

- 49.2.1(a) the name of the Federation
- 49.2.1(b) the title of the office
- 49.2.1(c) the form in which nominations are to be made
- 49.2.1(d) the place for lodging nominations;
- 49.2.1(e) the times and dates of the commencement of the period for lodging nominations:

and inviting nominations from persons, eligible for election for the office under the Rules of the Federation, to stand as candidates for election to that office.

Recommendation: Include an option for the Returning Officer to notify members of an election by electronic means when appropriate. The Returning Officer could then determine the most efficient and cost effective means to notify members of an election. This could then include notifying members by email rather than by advertising in multiple newspapers of an election.
